**5) Novice Tournaments: M: Edmonds/Wilson**

That the Novice Tournaments be held on February 21 - 23 and be organized as follows. **The entry fee is \$200 per team payable to the host community.**

**NOVICE A** – Teams in places 1 – 6 will play in Killarney. Round robin format, two pools of 3 teams. First place team in each pool will play the second place team from the other pool. Winners will play for the pennant. Third place teams will each other.

**NOVICE B** – Teams in places 7 – 12 will play in Reston. Round robin format, two pools of 3 teams. First place team in each pool will play the second place team from the other pool. Winners will play for the pennant. Third place teams will each other.

**NOVICE C** – Teams in places 13 – 17 will play in Deloraine. All teams will play in a round robin with the top two teams advancing to a final game for the pennant.

**6) Atom Playoff Draw: M: Houck/Snyder**

That the Atom League playoffs be organized as follows:

**ATOM A** – The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place team will get a bye in the first round, 3<sup>rd</sup> will play 6<sup>th</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> will play 5<sup>th</sup>. Winners from round one will move onto the championship series, losers from round one will move onto the consolation series. The 1<sup>st</sup> place team will play the lowest ranked team to advance. There will be no pennant for the consolation series. Round one is to be completed by February 16. Round two is to be completed by February 25. Round three is to be completed by March 4.

**ATOM B** – The 7<sup>th</sup> place team will get a bye in the first round, 8<sup>th</sup> will play 13<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> will play 12<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> will play 11<sup>th</sup>. Winners from round one will move onto the championship series, losers from round one will move onto the consolation series. The 7<sup>th</sup> place team will play the lowest ranked team to advance. There will be no pennant for the consolation series. Round one is to be completed by February 16. Round two is to be completed by February 25. Round three is to be completed by March 4.

**7) Pee Wee Playoff Draw: M: Vandenberghe/Edmonds**

That the Pee Wee League playoffs be organized as follows:

**PEE WEE** – The 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> place teams will play a single “survivor” game by February 13. The winner will play the 1<sup>st</sup> place team, 2<sup>nd</sup> will play 7<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> will play 6<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> will play 5<sup>th</sup> in the first round. The loser of the “survivor” game will play in the consolation side. Winners from round one will move onto the championship series, losers from round one will move onto the consolation series. The five teams on the consolation side will play a round robin format, with the top two teams playing for the Pee wee B pennant. Round one is to be completed by February 16. Round two and the round robin games are to be completed by February 29. Pee wee A and B finals are to be completed by March 11.

**8) Bantam Playoff Draw: M: White/Fry**

That the Bantam League playoffs be organized as follows:

**BANTAM A** – The 1<sup>st</sup> place team will play the 4<sup>th</sup> place team, 2<sup>nd</sup> will play 3<sup>rd</sup> in a best of three series. Winners of the first series will play for the championship banner in a best of five series. Losers of the first round will play in a best of five series on the consolation side. There will be no pennant for the consolation series. Round one is to be completed by February 19. Round two is to be completed by March 14.

**BANTAM B** – The 8<sup>th</sup> place team will play the 9<sup>th</sup> place team in round one. The winner will advance to the championship side and play the 5<sup>th</sup> place team in round two and the 6<sup>th</sup> place team will play the 7<sup>th</sup> place team. The winners in round two will play for the pennant, while the losers from round one and two will play on the consolation side. The team with the highest ranking from the regular season will get a bye. There will be no pennant for the consolation series. Round one is to be completed by February 16. Round two is to be completed by February 26. Round three is to be completed by March 14.

### **Determining Final Standings for All Age Groups**

- When determining which position a team will have in the playoffs, the following tie breaking formula will be used if teams have the same points after the regular season:
  - Record against each other
  - If still tied, number of wins
  - If still tied, goals for are divided by goals for plus goals against in the games played between the teams
  - If still tied, goals for are divided by goals for plus goals against for the entire season
  - If still tied, coin toss.

### **Atom, PeeWee, and Bantam Playoff Rules**

- All series will be best of three (unless otherwise noted) with the higher ranked team getting home game advantage.
- If games are tied after regulation, a 4 on 4, sudden victory overtime will be played until a winner is determined.

### **9) Completion Dates of each playoff round:**

### **10) Officiating in Playoffs: M: Wilson/Williamson**

- Officiating was discussed. It was determined that we should continue with last year's motion that "Officials will not be allowed to officiate games if they have an immediate family member on the team. Referees must be a minimum of two age groups above the age group they are officiating." Exceptional circumstances must exist to deviate from this rule with approval being received by the visiting team.
