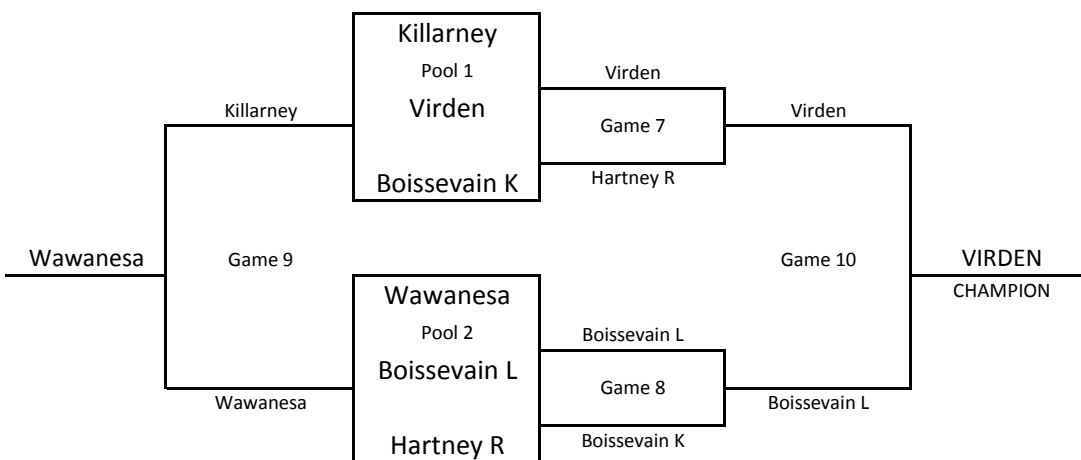

Novice Tournament Rules

Game Format

- Games will be 2 - 24 minute periods with play stoppage every 2 minutes to change players.
- All games must have 2 officials.
- Officials shall put the puck behind the net after goals.
- Any player receiving a penalty shall go to the player bench not the penalty box.
- Penalized players can return to the ice after a goal or at the next 2 minute stoppage (whatever happens first)
- If Round Robin games are tied after regulation, a 5 minute sudden victory, 4 on 4 overtime, will be played. If still tied, it remains tied.
- Teams get 2 points for a win, 1 for a tie, 1 for an OT loss.
- Teams with most points in the pool are first, etc.
- Ties after the Round Robin will be broken using Hockey Manitoba rules (pg 75).
- Ties in **non** Round Robin games will be decided by 4 on 4 sudden victory.
